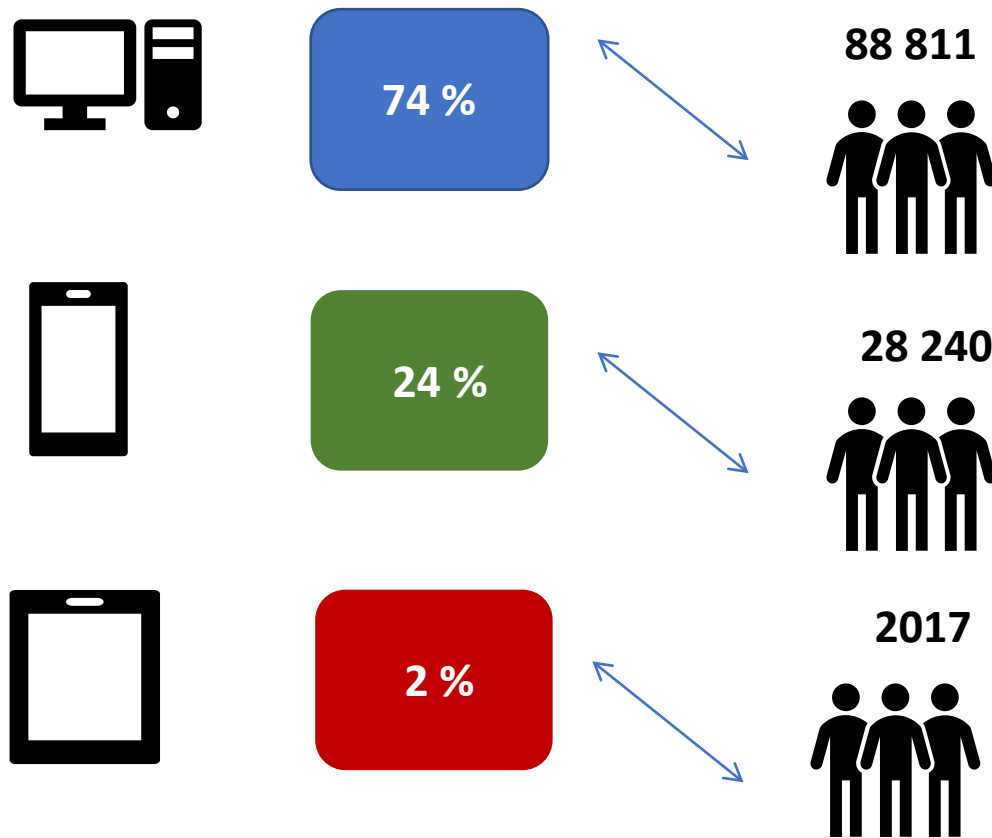
Geographical Circulation in 2020 on www.epilepticdisorders.com
