ACTIVITIES AND ACCOMPLISHMENTS

- The Korean Epilepsy Society Educational Program for YOUNG Epileptologists (KEEP YOUNG) was started from 2019 and has been providing a basic course such as classification of seizures and epilepsies, EEG, drug treatment, surgical treatment, etc. which any doctor specializing in epilepsy should be familiar with. It is a 2-day program meant to provide an in-depth introduction to epilepsy for the residents who are interested in epilepsy or want to major in epilepsy in the future and the instructors majoring in epilepsy. It is a valuable time to understand epilepsy as it covers multiple areas of epilepsy and helps to increase understanding of epilepsy and study systematically.
- Korean Epilepsy Congress is one of the biggest events of the year and representative
 epileptic scholars from the US, Europe, Australia, and Asia as well as domestic epilepsy
 experts are invited to present the latest findings on the diagnosis and treatment of
 epilepsy. In 2022, it was held in a hybrid format because COVID-19 was not completely
 over.
- Symposium of Epilepsy is an annual training course held in October on the introduction and use of anticonvulsants, medication use in special populations, and non-pharmacological therapies.
- A committee for prejudice measure of epilepsy in Korean Epilepsy Society supports
 projects conducted by National Epilepsy Care Center, designated by the Ministry of
 Health and Welfare, as a part of a research project. Running a project to support up to 2
 million won (KRW) in surgical expenses for patients who need surgery for the treatment
 of epilepsy and a seizure dog support project called "WE PROTECT YOU" to improve the
 quality of life for epilepsy patients.
- Professor Dr. Seung Bong Hong, a member of the Executive Steering Committee, was selected as the 2022 Asian & Oceanian Outstanding Achievement Epilepsy Award by ILAE and this award was made to recognize great leaders who have made extraordinary contributions to the treatment of epilepsy in ILAE Asia and Oceania.
